An Exposition of Proverbs by Charles Bridges (1794-1869) is regarded by some as one of the best commentaries ever written. Charles Spurgeon proclaimed it to be "the best commentary on the Proverbs." The commentary is especially useful because of its deep analysis of the text and its careful approach in applying the wisdom of God to man.

Bridges' work is among the more difficult books translated by RTF-USA, in that it is a large volume, written in an older style of English that provides certain challenges for translators. Nearing completion, we hope to offer this volume sometime in early 2023 as another contribution to our growing list of helpful commentaries for use in the church.



# A THEOLOGY OF CHRISTIAN COUNSELING BY JAY ADAMS

Jay Adams was an important leader in the development of the the Reformed Christian Counseling approach known as Nouthetic Counseling. RTF-USA is pleased to offer A Theology of Christian Counseling, a foundational book when first introduced in 1979. The text also includes a helpful introduction by Keith Evans, Professor of Biblical Counseling at Reformed Presbyterian Theological Seminary in Pittsburgh, PA.

Regarding the original publication of this book, Professor Evans notes, "What began as a vision, has grown into a self-conscious movement of demonstrating how the all-suffient Scriptures speak to every issue of life, providing us all we need to live a life of godliness in Christ Jesus." As in the US, there are many counseling issues in China that will benefit from this systematic and biblical

approach. It is our prayer to help provide these essential tools to pastors.

This summer, RTF-USA will publish 500 copies in the US for free distribution to students, pastors, churches, and seminaries. This volume joins two other books by Jay Adams on our website: From Forgiven to Forgiving and A Call for Discernment.

# **NEW AUDIOBOOK PROJECT**

A notable development in the modern publishing industry has been the recent rise in the popularity of audiobooks. With increased technology, more time waiting in traffic, and busy schedules, many readers seem to be opting for the convenience of listening to their favorite books, with less time to devote to reading physical books.

This popularity has also extended into other major world markets, most notably China and India. As China's interest in audiobooks has risen, the market has responded to meet the increased demand.

As RTF-USA has steadily increased its translation offerings online and in print, we have also noted the need to provide audio versions of the many excellent Reformed books posted at www.rtf-usa.com. Our progress has included the upgrading of our website, the purchase of some basic equipment, and recruitment of two excellent readers for the upcoming books. We have also been blessed with generous publishing partners who have agreed to allow their books to be posted in audio form on our website.

The recent upgrade to the RTF-USA website has given us a solid platform to stream these books around the world. Current updates include the addition

of an "Audio" tab and a layout designed for audiobooks.

Our recordings will start with the following books, with hopefully many more to add in 2023:

- -Luke, Acts, and Romans by RC Sproul
- -The Lord's Day by Joey Pipa
- -Love to Christ (M'Cheyne) by Jordan Stone
- -The Puritan Treasures for Today series



#### URDU UPDATE

RTF-USA and the Urdu Center for Reformed Theology (UCRT) have brought *The Lord's Day* by Joey Pipa a little closer to the press in early 2023, with 2000 copies in progress. The new cover design has been finalized and is ready for publication. These volumes will be freely distributed to Urdu churches in Pakistan, thanks to your contributions and prayers.

Please pray for these continuing efforts to bring Reformed books to Urdu churches. UCRT desires your prayer for their daily work and for an upcoming missionary trip to distribute books and to support the church.

Our plan is to pursue more Urdu translation work in 2023, to select new books for translation, and to add all current books to our new website.

#### SPANISH BOOKS

Two books on ecclesiology and the sacraments are in progress. An Assertion of Church Government by George Gillespie and The Mystery of the Lord's Supper by Robert Bruce are currently in the translation process. In addition, RTF-USA is also pleased to be helping with the production of a new Spanish Psalter, specifically produced for use in Central and South America.

### **HINDI PROGRESS**

Three Hindi books are in progress. Our translators are working on The Lord's Day by Joey Pipa, The Ruling Elder by Samuel Miller, and The Apostolic Church by Thomas Witherow. These books will help in providing solid foundational materials for pastors and teachers. In addition, RTF-USA is partnering with Ligonier ministries to help produce a Hindi version of Surprised by Suffering by R. C. Sproul.

## **2023 LIGONIER CONFERENCE**

Whenever possible, RTF-USA presents a display table at the annual Ligonier Conference in Orlando, Florida. We hope to be in attendance again this year, with a table secured at the Orange County Convention Center on March 23-25, 2023. These kinds of displays are important in order to get the word out regarding our important ministry and to gather new names and addresses for our Newsletter mailings.

Especially important is the nurturing of our relationship with Ligonier Ministries. RTF-USA has had a connection to Dr. RC Sproul since 1993, when he kindly agreed to serve on our Board of Reference, a voluntary board that provides theological advice and guidance in our effort to translate the

very best books for the church.

In recent years, Ligonier has been a wonderful partner in our translation and publishing work. In fact, we have been able to translate 42 of Dr. Sproul's titles because of the generous cooperation of Ligonier Ministries. These books include simplified Chinese versions of the 38 Crucial Questions booklets for new Christians and three volumes of the Expository Commentary series. Future projects include the addition of 1&2 Peter and cooperative Hindi projects as well. Will you help support these worthy projects?

To update our display, we've added some modern banners, some promotional items, and a full list of our current books posted online. The display includes all of the current stock of physical books available in the US, as well as some books that are a part of our upcoming translation work. Please pray that our booth will be able to generate more interest in our work and that our outreach will grow through these ministry efforts.

# LUKE PROGRESS UPDATE

The latest commentary offering of *Luke* by RC Sproul has been completed and is now available online. We are hoping to someday have all eight of Dr. Sproul's commentaries in print.
